Authorized Payor for Stage One and Bridge Program Transitional Subsidy Payment and Cost-Plus monthly payments:

Child Development Associates, Inc. San Diego County, CA

Pursuant to SB 140 and an agreement with Child Care Providers United (CCPU) investments have been made to supplement subsidized child care reimbursements.

In counties where the Stage One and or Bridge Programs are administered in-house by the county and where no business relationship exists between the Stage One/Bridge Program child care provider and an APP, CDSS has contracted with **Child Development Associates**, **Inc (CDA) in San Diego County** to issue payments to those providers directly.

These payments include:

A one-time Transitional subsidy payment, child care providers who received a subsidy payment in April 2023 will receive:

\$500	per license-exempt family child care provider
\$2,500	per small licensed family child care provider (6-8 children)
\$3,000	per large licensed family child care provider (12-14 children)
\$3,000	per each licensed or licensed exempt child care center

Monthly Cost of Care Plus Rate, per-child payment, beginning January 2024 through June 2025, all provider types will receive a per child payment in addition to their regular per child subsidy payment. The amount per child varies based on the county/region where the provider is located. For a list of all the regions and per child rates visit Child Care Bulletin 23-37.

Stage One/Bridge Program child care providers may be contacted by CDA by email or phone call to collect W9 information to allow for the issuance of these payments. This is necessary because the IRS requires accurate reporting of taxpayer identification when income is paid to individuals or businesses.

CDA may also contact providers to verify contact information, license type, and other necessary information for accuracy of payment calculations and to ensure payments reach the intended recipient.
